

Survival instinct Denmark's premier says Europe must pull together for its defence

Europe needs to adopt an “emergency mindset” on deterrence and defence if it is to survive a global disorder where strength matters above all, Denmark’s prime minister has warned.

Mette Frederiksen, thrust by the Greenland crisis into the centre of a rupturing transatlantic alliance, told the FT that “a Europe that is not able and willing to protect itself is going to
