

# Trump in 'invasion' threat to Greenland

## U.S PLANNING TO ATTACK ITS ALLIES

A senior administration official said: "The President and his team are discussing a range of options to pursue this important foreign policy goal.



"Utilising the US military is always an option."

Denmark, Italy, Poland and Spain, Keir Starmer, Emmanuel Macron and Friedrich Merz said: "It is for Denmark and Greenland, and them only, to decide on matters concerning Denmark and Greenland."

It comes after Trump said that the US "needed" Greenland for security reasons.

Sir Keir Starmer later repeated British support for Denmark at a press conference in Paris where Trump's son-in-law Jared Kushner and special envoy Steve Witkoff were present.

The Orange Manbaby has made clear that acquiring the isle is a "national security priority", a spokesman said.

But Trump is emboldened after the US seized Venezuelan president Nicolás Maduro and hauled him before a court in New York.

Options include purchasing the land or granting Greenland's people independence while taking charge of its defence. But Denmark
