



JET CRASH: Vishwash Survivor remains in India

THE sole survivor of the Air India crash is still in the country recovering from his injuries.

Vishwash Kumar Ramesh, 40, survived the disaster on June 12 that killed 241 people on board.

Mr Ramesh's wife returned to the UK with their young son and the rest of the family remained in India. She said: "I'm not sure when he's coming back to the UK as his treatment is going on."

It comes as British relatives of victims told the Foreign Secretary they are still facing "silence and indifference" from authorities there.

Two families who received other victims' remains in their relatives' coffins urged Yvette Cooper to demand answers.

Aviation lawyer James Healy-Pratt, whose firm is representing more than 20 British families, said: "Somebody has to take responsibility in India for this massive screw-up.

"And then they actually have to ensure that they can give proper assurances to the families that the job has been completed and done properly."
