

# Indian Vice President to visit SL today

The 15th Vice President of India and Chairman of the Rajya Sabha, C.P. Radhakrishnan, will arrive in Sri Lanka today for a two-day official visit, marking the first-ever bilateral visit by an Indian Vice President to the country.

A senior Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) leader from Tamil Nadu, he previously served as the Governor of Maharashtra.

During his visit from 19 to 20 April, he is scheduled to call on President Anura Kumara Dissanayake and hold discussions with Prime Minister Harini Amarasuriya. He is also expected to meet several other dignitaries and representatives of the Indian Diaspora in Sri Lanka.

Sri Lanka remains a key

partner in India's regional outreach, particularly under its Vision MAHASAGAR and the Neighbourhood First Policy. The visit follows a series of recent high-level engagements between the two countries and is expected to further strengthen longstanding bilateral relations and deep-rooted people-to-people ties spanning centuries.
