



Risky crossroad for nuclear-armed foes

A family member is overcome by grief Wednesday during the funeral procession of an Indian man gunned down Tuesday when militants launched an ambush in Indian-controlled Kashmir. A fragile ceasefire between India and Pakistan, both of which claim the region and administer separate parts of it, is at risk after the indiscriminate attack on a crowd of mostly tourists, the deadliest on civilians in India in more than a decade.
